



SwachhSurvekshan 2017 in SMC

In order to foster a healthy competition between cities for improving cleanliness standards, the Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) started the “SwachhSurvekshan” survey, ranking of cities on cleanliness and other aspects of urban sanitation, in 2016 which ranked 73 cities across the country. On the same lines, MoUD has initiated “SwachhSurvekshan” 2017 which will conduct a survey to rank 500 cities of India. The performance evaluation of the Swachhsurvekshan is conducted by Quality Council of India (QCI), an autonomous body established by Government of India in 1997 for Quality assurance in all spheres of activities including Governance.

To be conducted by Quality Council of India (QCI), the 'Swachh Survekshan-2017' will judge cities on the basis of data provided by Municipal bodies which will carry 900 marks, data collected through direct observations and independent assessment (500 marks) and citizen feedbacks (600 marks). As you are aware that, Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) is implementing Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) Urban with a goal to make the country clean and open defecation free by 2nd October, 2019.

In that sense, the survey is more holistic, participatory, purposeful and meaningful for future guidance and evolving course of action, "SwachhSurvekshan 2017 was conducted in SMC from 2nd Feb 2017 to 4th Feb 2017 by Quality Council of India (QCI). A team of 3 members from QCI verified the documents of SMC and visited different places of SMC for assessment of ODF, Solid waste, Transportation & collection of disposal, Door to door collection, Community Toilet (CT), Public Toilet (PT) etc.

Citizen Feedback:

As you know SwachhSurvekshan assessments are underway across the city. One of the major components of the survey is citizen's feedback. In light of the overwhelming response received so far, it has been extended the last date for obtaining citizen feedback from 12th Feb to 28th Feb, 2017. The citizen feedback carries 600 marks. Out of this, 150 marks for SwachhataApp and 450 marks for feedback collected through these sources. Minimum response required is 35000. The extended deadline will also apply to SwachhataApp. We will primarily focus on download of "**SwachhataApp**". We would like to encourage the citizen to download the **swachhata App** in their android phone and take the benefits. So please encourage everybody's to download "**Swachhata App**" from **Google play store**.
